

SENSES is a registered charity that supports families of preschool children with additional learning, physical, or medical needs in Scarborough and the surrounding area. Qualified and experienced staff run two weekly toddler groups, (one at the Oasis Centre and one every Tuesday during term-time in Eastfield at Westway Open Arms) which provide multi-sensory experiences, and the opportunity for parent-to-parent support relationships to develop. A Walk and Talk service is also available for individual families to meet a staff member and discuss any specific support requirements.

There is a Monday coffee morning at WOA twice a month, where parents and carers of children and young people with additional needs can meet.
